The 8th meeting of the Indian Library Association (ILA) Executive Committee (2016-2019) was held at central Library, University of Delhi, on Friday, the 6th April, 2018 at 4.00P.M. The following members attended the meeting:

Proceedings

Before taking up the agenda, Prof. Shabahat Husain, President, ILA welcomed all the members of the Executive Committee. The following business was transacted as per the agenda:-

Agenda Item No. 1: Confirmation of minutes of the 7th Executive Committee held on 23 Nov 2017 at the venue of the 63rd ILA Conference, at Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow (U.P).

The draft minutes of 7th meeting were already circulated through e-mail to all the members. As no comments were received, the house approved the same.

Agenda Item No. 2: Approval of ILA Membership up to 31st December 2017.

The house approved the new membership of ILA since the last meeting until 31st December 2017.

Agenda Item No. 3: Next ILA Conference related matter.

General Secretary informed the house that no written request regarding holding of Annual Conference has yet been received by the ILA office till date. However, two requests were made telephonically, one from Jaipur and another from Manipur University. The House decided that once the written requests from Heads of concerned institutions are received the place and venue of ILA Conference will be decided.

Agenda Item No. 4: Action taken report of various committees appointed by Executive Committee.

EC approved the expenditure estimates put up by the committee constituted for renovation of ILA Office. The house, further advised the committee concerned to get the renovation work completed during the next three months positively, as it has already been delayed.

Agenda Item No. 5: Any other item with the permission of the chair

ILA received a proposal from Informatics Publishing Limited , 194, RV Road, Basavanagudi, Bangalore 560004 regarding "Journal of Indian Library Association "for Aggregation and Promotion on i-Scholar Platform (www.i-scholar.in). House discussed the matter in detail and decided to approve the proposal only for on-line version, as there is no extra cost involved, rather ILA may earn revenue from it. The General Secretary was authorized to look into the further details and complete the required formalities.

The meeting came to an end with a vote of thanks to the chair.

• Springer Nature, Cambridge University Press, Thieme and ResearchGate announce New Cooperation Agreement

To make the navigation of legal sharing of academic journal articles easier, three publishers namely Springer Nature, Cambridge University Press, Thieme and ResearchGate announce new cooperation on 19 April 2018. In a cooperation agreement they will work together on the sharing of articles on the scholarly collaboration platform in such a way that protects the rights of authors and publishers. Ultimately the agreement includes publishers who want to help and support content sharing and rely on that working with ResearchGate is one of the important means to achieve this. As part of the agreement, the ResearchGate and publishers will cooperate in educating users about their rights in relation to copyright-protected content by providing users with more and better information about how and when they may share their journal articles on the network. The ResearchGate will continue to promptly remove copyright-infringing content when alerted by publishers and the Publishers will get better visibility into the usage of new content on the platform that was originally published in their journals. This agreement is the conclusion of negotiations between ResearchGate and publishers which was announced in the last autumn. It indicates that cooperation on the sharing of publisher content can be found and demonstrates the commitment from all parties to make sure that researchers are able to access and share high quality scholarly research reliably.

• Kate Zwaard appointed New Director of Digital Strategy at the Library of Congress

Carla Hayden, Librarian of Library of Congress, declared on April 20, 2018 that she has appointed Kate Zwaard as the Library's director of digital strategy. It is a position established by Hayden to uplift the institution's digital planning and drive envisaging and cooperation around digital initiatives. Hayden said "When I think of the resources of the Library of Congress, married with the capabilities of today's technology, the possibilities are almost limitless. This new role will drive the internal conversations and collaboration that will improve our ability to conduct traditional work efficiently and effectively and lead to whole new ways for users to experience the Library. We are thinking big."

Earlier, Zwaard was head of the National Digital Initiatives division, where she built up Library Labs and the new innovator-in-residence program, among different projects. She will keep on overseeing those projects in her new part. She already dealt with the team of software developers and system engineers supporting the digital repository from 2011 through 2016. Before going to the Library of Congress, she drove the development team in charge of the digital preservation data architecture at the U.S. Government Publishing Office from 2002 through 2011.

• Top 10 list of most 'challenged' books released

Certain books get applaud for their cutting edge composing style and story, and some of the time, they draw feedback for similar reasons. The ALA (American Library Association) on 9th April released its list of the top 10 most challenged books in 2017 as an approach to commence National Library Week. Topping the list is Jay Asher's "Thirteen Reasons Why," recently made well known by the Netflix adaptation, and "The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian," by Sherman Alexie's which was published nearby 10 years ago. The association's Office for Intellectual Freedom said in its 2018 State of America's Libraries report that it traced 354 challenges to library, school and university materials in 2017, up from 323 a year ago. Nevertheless, the association believes there can be as many as 10,766 challenged that stay unreported every year. A challenge is characterized as a "formal, composed objection documented with a library or school asking for that materials be evacuated on account of substance or suitability."

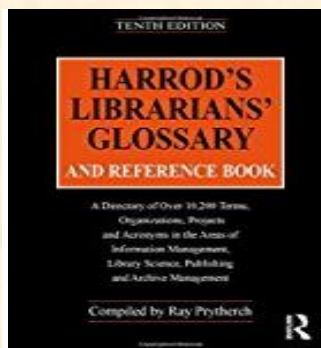


Report of Silver Jubilee Celebration of Pustakalaya Parishad, Jodhpur

Pustakalaya Parishad, Jodhpur celebrated silver jubilee celebration at Hotel Shri Ram Excellency Jodhpur on 25th March, 2018. On the eve of this occasion, 22nd one day conference was held on the topic **'Library in 2020'**. The Chief guest Dr. P. K. Khatri, HOD of Dr. S.N. Medical College and Dr. Kshema Prakash, Deputy Librarian, IIT Jodhpur inaugurated the conference by lightning the lamp and garlanding Maa Saraswati and Padamshree Dr. S. R. 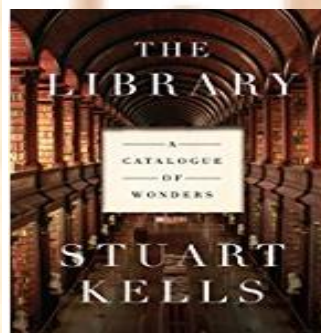

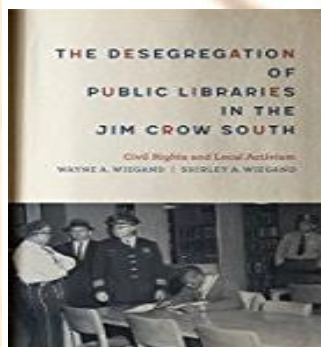
