Professional News

• Introduction of Constitution (Amendment) Bill regarding the "Libraries"

Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Shri Tej Pratap Singh Yadav has introduced the Constitution (Amendment) Bill on 3rd August 2018 in the Lok Sabha. The Bill seeks to amend the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India with a view to transfer the subject 'Libraries', from "state list" to "concurrent list" so that the Parliament and the Central Government can also play its vital role in the overall development of a National Library Policy, systems and services in the country. National Knowledge Commission, too, recommended the need for this amendment to the constitution in its 2006 Report entitled "Libraries: Gateways to Knowledge - A roadmap for revitalization". Indian Library Association congratulates and thanks Hon'ble MP for his contribution and effort of raising the issue of development of library sector in the country.

• New York University receives \$1.34m grant to support online Arabic library

New York University Libraries announced that a grant of \$1.34 million has been made by Arcadia-a charitable fund of Lisbet Rausing and Peter Baldwin on 21-08-2018 to support Arabic Collections Online (ACO). Arabic Collections Online (ACO) is a major project to create an open access, digital library of public-domain Arabic language content. It is a partnership between NYU New York and New York University Abu Dhabi (NYUAD) which began in 2013. ACO aims to digitize 23,000 volumes from NYU as well as partner institutions and make them accessible to the public on the ACO website. NYU expects to reach this goal by the end of 2020. NYU's Digital Library Technology Services developed and manages the online interface, a web portal accessible around the world. More than 8,785 volumes have already been posted on the site which covers above 5,600 subjects. Thousands of subjects are covered by the books in fiction, poetry, literature, criticism, culture and society, economics, history, law, biography, and Arabic language and grammar. ACO ensures that their content is saved digitally for future generations as they are very old material and many of the older books are rare or fragile, and nearly all are out of print. Ph.D Awarded

Obituary

Library scientist Krishna Shripadrao Deshpande, 95, died at his residence in Malamaddi. He was born in Dharwad on May 5, 1924 and studied at Karnatak High School, Karnatak College and completed his masters in Kannada and English. After obtaining B.Lib degree from Bombay University in 1950, he joined Karnatak University as assistant librarian and later became the chief librarian. He was instrumental in establishing the Library Science Department in Karnatak University in 1962. The American Library Association conferred him the honorary diploma in 1956. He was recognized internationally as an expert in Library Science, and was instrumental in setting up and developing libraries at Karnatak University, Gulbarga University, UAS, Dharwad, Mangalore University, Bangalore University and Goa University. He has authored several books on various facets of library science. The grandson of Ra Ha Deshpande, founder of the Karnatak Vidyavardhaka Sangha, Deshpande had participated in the freedom movement and was active in social organizations. The State government had honoured him with the Rajyotsava award in 1993 and he also received the Kaula-Ranganath award. The last rites were performed at Hosayallapur crematorium.




