• National Library Teams Up with Ministry of Education to Increase Digital Literacy

A Memorandum of Cooperation has been signed between the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of Georgia and the National Library of Georgia, signed by Minister Mikheil Batiashvili and Director of the Library Giorgi Kekelidze in order to increase the level of digital literacy among Georgians. The initiative was perceived in the sense that it is impossible to get a quality education and become a free person without modern, electronic communications and information technologies. Consequently, the National Library's collection, which offers electronic access to books, periodicals, cartographic materials, dissertations, archival documents and other material resources, is essential for increasing public awareness.

Parties' collaboration will include coordination and promotion of cooperation between the Ministry and the National Library, as well as exchanges of information and sharing experiences on how to create a national digital library. Moreover, the Memorandum facilitates the joint development of digital and audio versions of library holdings as well as also provides access to the digital library for interested people.

• iSchool Launches New Hub For Public Libraries Research

A new School of Information Studies (iSchool) initiative is serving as a discovery zone for public library innovation, and a means to circulate new ideas and research findings to public library professionals. It is a hub for student inquiry on librarianship topics. The newly established "iSchool Public Libraries Initiative," (IPLI) led by Associate Professor of Practice Jill Hurst-Wahl as director, has several key purposes. It creates an intellectual home for iSchool faculty and students who want to research public library topics and apply the knowledge they discover. Secondly, the initiative offers iSchool master's-degree Library Information Science (MSLIS) students and others a faculty-supported research hub focused on topics in their field. In a third vein, students and faculty are helping public libraries build added capacity for innovation by sharing the information research projects uncover.

• Tencent and National Museum of Brazil collaborate on a digital museum

On November 19, 2018 Tencent, a leading provider of Internet value-added services in China, announced its support to restore the fire-damaged National Museum of Brazil by reproducing artifacts based on digital information. At the Brazilian embassy in Beijing on November 16, 2018, the signing ceremony for the "Rebirth of Luzia - The Digital National Museum of Brazil" was held.

Tencent will build an online museum with existing digital content of the museum by using Tencent Lens, an image recognition feature of its QQ Browser. By scanning images with Tencent Lens or Mr. Bowu, a mini program of Tencent, visitors will be able to read information of the artifacts. QQ Browser will showcase the valuable content with the public in future.

Obituary

Juran Krishna Sarkhel, a senior professor of library and information science, died of cardiac arrest while introducing keynote speakers at a national seminar in Kalyani University on 29-12-2018. He was 63.

Sarkhel, a former interim registrar and vice-chancellor of the university, collapsed on the podium around 12.30pm. "After the inaugural programme, Professor Sarkhel delivered an introductory speech. He later started introducing the keynote speakers. Then he apparently had pain in the chest. He collapsed before anybody could figure out what was going on. He was rushed to the hospital but it was too late," said a student present at the seminar titled "Libraries in Next Era: Digital Learning Landscape".

Sarkhel, a resident of Rishra in Hooghly, was a former director of the university's distance learning department. He had also served for two decades at Vidyasagar University.

Sarkhel had obtained MLIS and PhD from Jadavpur University. He had also served as a Visiting Scientist in the Indian Statistical Institute, Bangalore, and was a board member in many universities.

Kalyani University's vice-chancellor Sankar Kumar Ghosh and many teachers and students rushed to the hospital to pay their tributes to Sarkhel.

Sumit Mukherjee, former dean of arts, described Sarkhel as a great teacher. "He was also a sensitive person. His death is a great loss to students. Personally, it is an irreparable loss for me." Sarkhel is survived by wife Gouri, a teacher of Bengali literature, and two children.




