#### India launches National Digital Library

Mr. Prakash Javadekar, the Union Human Development Minister, launched the National Digital Library in the country's capital on 19 June 2018. The library will be open to the general public as a source of millions of academic texts from around the world. The National Digital Library will make learning resources available to users, the library has over 17 million source materials from more than 160 sources, in over 200 languages and according to the press release, around 3 million users are registered on the National Digital Library, said Mr. Prakash Javadekar. The National Digital Library of India (NDLI) is a project of the Ministry under the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT). The goal of National Digital Library is to make digital educational resources available to all Indian citizens to empower, inspire and encourage learning.

The Ministry has also made the National Digital Library available on phones through its mobile application, a part from single online platform- the website. By using National Digital Library Mobile App people will be able to access a vast reservoir of digital content from not only the country but across the world as well. Digital information will be able to reach users even the most remote parts of India.

The National Digital Library is a digital repository containing textbooks, articles, videos, audiobooks, lectures, simulations, fiction and other kinds of learning media. In order to increase efficiency through time and cost savings it uses a single-window system. It is a platform which collects and organizes metadata from leading learning institutions in India and from the world across.

The new Open Access policy is not only ensuring that FAO's wealth of knowledge remains easily accessible to users around the world, but also actively encouraging and providing a framework for the broader use, reproduction and dissemination of this material.

Enrique Yeves, Director of the Office of Corporate Communications, said: "This policy is recognition of the importance that FAO places on the universal right of access to information. FAO knowledge is a global public good, and it should be free of unreasonable barriers to access for those who need it most".

From now on FAO publications and documents published in the FAO online Document Repository are covered by this new policy and original licensing conditions apply on its earlier publications which may require permission. Third parties can make use of FAO's published works in more and easier ways, with the implementation of this policy, by reproducing them, using snippets, and adapting them for their own ends. The policy will particularly benefit member states, policy makers, researchers and others engaged in sharing information in support of resolving global hunger issues and achieving the Sustainable Development Goals - most of which require constant scientific input.
