- **NZ Library places second in international marketing award**

New Zealand’s Invercargill City Library has placed second in the 2018 BibLibre International Marketing Award, run by the International Federation of Library Associations and Institutions (IFLA). Using the headline ‘Keeping up with the librarians’ the campaign endeavour to connect the library with a wider audience, particularly younger generations. The objective behind was to prove how libraries are relevant in the digital age by combining pop-culture references and humour. Digital and communications manager ‘Bonnie Mager’ said: “Our goals are to remind people that libraries are not dead”. Fifty-six submissions were received from around the world for the award, including 35 academic libraries and 21 public libraries. To tackle the prevalence of students engaging a third party to complete their assessments, sometimes referred to as contract cheating, the new software called ‘Author Investigation’ will bring out by University anti-plagiarism software company Turnitin. This new product will identify instances of contract cheating by building a profile of a student’s writing style and using machine learning algorithms and ‘forensic linguistic best practices’ to detect major differences in a student’s style. Report of International Workshop on “Design and Development of Library Website using Wix Website Builder”

A One-day International workshop on “**Design and Development of Library Website using Wix Website Builder**” was organized by Central Library, Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), Tuljaur Campus on 25 January, 2018. About 50 participants from various parts of India participated actively in the workshop.

The workshop was inaugurated by keynote speaker Prof. Kathryn LaBarre, School of Information Science, University of Illinois, UAS. During the inaugural session, Dr. Veeresh Hanchinal, coordinator of the workshop said that the primary objective of the workshop is to create an awareness among the professionals to develop responsive library/institutes website using open sources such as Wix website builder.

Dr. Satish Kanamadi, Librarian, TISS, Mumbai in his special address emphasized how to meet the user’s requirements within the campus and outside the campus by building responsive library website. 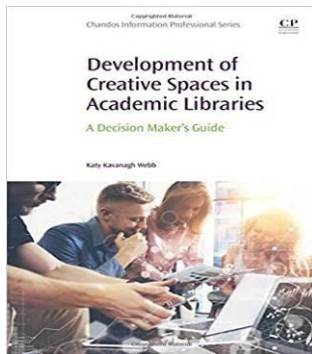

Dr. Mallikarjun Angadi was the resource person who engaged theory and practical classes. He demonstrated to the participants live creation of website using **Wix website builder** online.

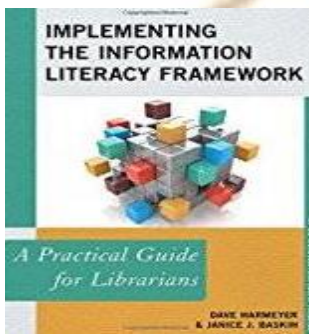

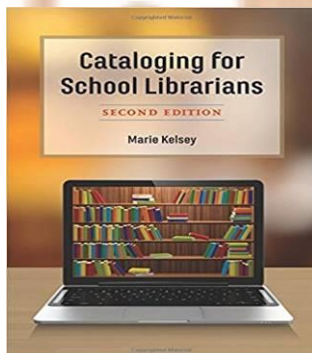

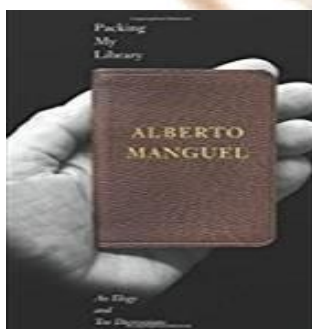
