Professional News

- **Public Health Library merges with Bioscience & Natural Resources Library**

Two significant libraries in the division of Life & Health Sciences will come together under one roof as the Marian Koshland Bioscience, Natural Resources & Public Health Library on June 2018. The Sheldon Margen Public Health Library which is located in University Hall at Oxford Street and University Avenue will close on June 1 and its Library staff and collections will be incorporated into the Bioscience & Natural Resources Library in the Valley Life Sciences Building. The Course reserves for the School of Public Health and will be available to students for the summer semester are already being shifted to the Valley Life Sciences Building location. The Library declared a call for comment in September and received feedback from several departments and key campus stakeholders in order to achieve this decision. The reconfiguration originates after months of collaboration between librarians and deans from the School of Public Health, the College of Natural Resources, and the Division of Biological Sciences. Last year in an announcement the University Librarian Jeff MacKie-Mason stated that the library will continue to memorialize Sheldon Margen's contributions to the School of Public Health, the university, and other related field. The Public Health Library and Bioscience & Natural Resources Library collections support interdisciplinary subject areas, including health, nutrition, toxicology, and disease. But by joining together their resources and expertise they would be able to better serve the multidisciplinary research and learning.

- **USPTO Designates Durango, Colorado Public Library a Patent and Trademark Resource Center**

The grand opening of the newest Patent and Trademark Resource Center (PTRC) at the Durango Public Library in Durango, Colorado was announced by the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) on Tuesday May 22, 2018. A free public program will be presented, name as "Researching Patent and Trademark Information: Essential Information You Need to Protect Your Intellectual Property". The Durango Public Library will serve residents in southwestern Colorado and northern New Mexico. It will be the second PTRC in the State of Colorado.. The Durango Public Library is in the Four Corners region of Colorado, which includes the Ute Mountain Ute and Southern Ute Nations. The entrepreneurs throughout the region seeking patent and trademark protection for their intellectual property will be supported by the library. Trained librarians of UPSTO will assist patrons using the agency's patent and trademark databases.

PTRCs provide free services, including aid in accessing patent and trademark documents, help in using USPTO databases, and assistance in identifying resources available on the USPTO website. They are a countrywide network of public, state, and academic libraries which support inventors, intellectual property attorneys and agents, business people, researchers, entrepreneurs, students, historians, and members of the public unable to visit USPTO campuses. Public seminars on IP topics for novice and experienced innovators are also host by the PTRCs. The PTRC Program began in 1871 when federal law first provided for the distribution of printed patents to public libraries. The addition of the Durango Public Library to the PTRC network makes a total of 86 resource centers located in 48 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico.

IFLA Global Vision 2018 Regional workshop Asia & Oceania, on 23-25 May 2018 at Hanoi, Vietnam.

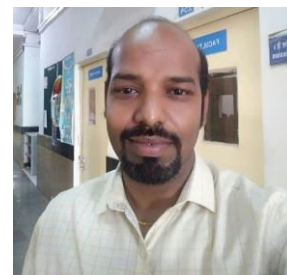
