Professional News

Library of Congress launches Online Project based on Crowdsourcing

• On 24 October, 2018 Library of Congress has launched crowd.loc.gov., which is a Crowdsourcing program that will connect the Library with virtual volunteers to transcribe text in digitized images from the Library's historic collections. This project empowers anyone with access to a computer to experience first-hand accounts in history while contributing to the Library's ability to make these treasures more searchable and readable. Volunteers can work on selections from the papers of Abraham Lincoln and Mary Church Terrell, Clara Barton's diaries, Branch Rickey's baseball scouting reports or memoirs of Civil War veterans with disabilities from the William Oland Bourne Papers. Carla Hayden, Librarian of Congress said "Crowdsourcing demonstrates the passion of volunteers for history, learning and the power of technology to make those things more accessible. The pages awaiting transcription at crowd.loc.gov represent some of the diversity of the Library's treasure, and the metadata that will result from these transcriptions mean these digitized documents will have even greater use to classrooms, researchers or anyone who is curious about these historical figures." The Library will continue to add new material, including documents from the Rosa Parks papers, the woman's suffrage movement, Civil War veterans, American poets and the history of psychiatry. Crowd.loc.gov will launch with the Letters to Lincoln Challenge, inviting the public to transcribe 10,000 digital images from the Abraham Lincoln papers by the end of 2018.

Closing the Gap between University Presses and Libraries

• By creating their own distribution platforms, MIT Press and the University of Michigan Press both have announced plans to start selling their ebook collections directly to libraries. Previously the publishers did not have a mechanism for selling directly to institutions. Ebooks are largely brokered through third-party acquisition services such as EBSCO, ProQuest, OverDrive, Project Muse and JSTOR instead of providing access.

There will be no limit on the number of people who can access one ebook at a time, a common restriction on content sold through aggregators. The University of Michigan Press is planning to offer its ebook collection directly to libraries in the next few months. Director of the press, Charles Watkinson, said the ebook collection will launch in January 2019 on Fulcrum, an open-source publishing platform being developed with funding from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation. Executive director of the Association of University Presses, Peter Berkery said it was too soon to describe the movement as a trend. "There's a lot of experimentation," he said, noting the unlikeliness of all university presses deciding to start selling directly to customers any time soon. Many university presses will be watching the progress of MIT and Michigan's efforts with interest".

Over century old library to get digital push

• The Central Archaeological Library was established in 1902 and now the entire collection of centuries-old rare books at the library is all set to be digitized for preservation in the coming months. The Library is a treasure trove of historical texts, publications and pictures having 1.5 lakh books, including 25,000 precious compilations of manuscripts, sketches, drawings, handwritten notes and images. The Central Archaeological library is owned by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). Bengali novel Gaudrajmala that was published in 1319 is one of the oldest possessions of the library. Director General (DG) of ASI, Usha Sharma, said digitization of the collection of rare books was an ambitious project, which would take off soon. The unique assortment of published work housed in the library includes Collection of Ishqiyya and Other Trades (philosophy on Sufism by different authors in English, 1332), Sirai-i-Imani-i-Rabbani, the being and biography of Hadvat Shaikh Ahmad, Duyadid-i-aif-e-thane of Sarhind (a biography of sufi saint in English, 1347), Voyage Round the World by John Francis (reference book based on travel accounts in English, 1693), and Journey from India towards England (travel accounts in English, 1797), and Reflection on the Government of Indosland (Politics in English, 1739).

• The new edition of Dubai Digital Library (DDL), launched by the Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Knowledge Foundation (MBRF) as it takes part in GITEX Technology Week 2018, held at the Dubai World Trade Centre on October 14-18. In order to make knowledge available and accessible to all sectors of society all around the world, the Dubai Digital Library enriches online Arabic-language content to keep up with modern times and the requirements and demands of current generations. It is announced by the foundation that registration for the Library is now open and free of charge for all citizens and residents of the UAE, which allows them to benefit from its valuable content, promotes reading in the local community, and facilitates their access to knowledge material across all sectors and from the convenience of their smart devices.

Currently, the Dubai Digital Library houses around 100,000 titles, including books, periodicals, heritage material, and summaries from the "A Book in Minutes" initiative, which MBRF issues after translating international best sellers into Arabic. Meanwhile, the Library's digital content includes entire books, as well as separate chapters from a book, articles, manuscripts, and children's books. It covers a wide array of topics such as philosophy, religion, social science, languages, science, technology, art, history, geography, and translations.






