Professional News

• Call for Public Participation in Rebuilding Flood-damaged Libraries in Kerala

According to an initial estimate by the Kerala Library Council, around 228 libraries affiliated with the council have been either seriously damaged or washed away in the recent Kerala floods. Soiled books, smashed furniture, damaged equipment and rooms filled with mud tugged at the heartstrings of volunteers and officials at flood-hit public libraries in Kerala as they went to clean. The Council has around 9,000 libraries affiliated with it while 6,000 of them receive grants from the council. However, activists said the number of damages libraries which are not affiliated with the council will be much higher as the state has the tradition of most organisations, clubs and social groups building their own libraries. The participation of civil society and professional agencies has also been called by the activists for rebuilding the libraries in these areas. A report on the damages happened to the libraries from the flood affected areas have been submitted by the Talukas in the state. Right now, the preference and priorities of the government is different and the funding for rebuilding libraries may not get a priority. Kerala's famed library movement needs the support of general public and organisations now. Besides, the intervention of civil society, the intervention of professional agencies involved in the library movement across the country has been called for.

Dr. Shibu, Assistant Librarian, Pondicherry University opined that "Rebuilding of these libraries are, definitely, not anywhere near to the priority list of the State government at present. However, national agencies like Raja Rammohan Roy Library Foundation and professional bodies like Indian Library Association (ILA), Indian Association of Special Libraries and Information Centres (IASLIC), Indian Association of Teachers of Library and Information Science (IATLIS), etc. could lend their hands in restoring these libraries in the affected area offering books and other resources".

• Tamil Nadu Digital Library (TNDL) just a click away

The recently launched Tamil Nadu Digital Library (TNDL) – (http://www.tndigitallibrary.org/) is turning out to be a preferred choice of too many people as it contains information about different types of digital contents, including books, articles, videos, audio, thesis and other educational material relevant for users ranging from students to researchers and library users to professionals. According to an official, the portal has been designed to benefit all users including the differently-abled besides 'all other lifelong learners.' He said, "This is the first of its kind initiative in Tamil Nadu, providing a single-window search facility to act as a one-stop point for all digital resources available in 13 universities and its affiliated colleges in Tamil Nadu,"

"This is something like a 'customized service' provided round the clock to match the needs of the users. However, access to full text in many cases might require institutional membership. Otherwise, access to the digital library is absolutely free. Over 5,000 e-resources in addition to nearly 10,00,000 bibliographic information with the option of download content/view online feature have been provided,"

The e-resources of the TNDL can be accessed at the click of a mouse and consider as an excellent fountainhead for knowledge resource. N. Baskaran, a sthapathi and temple modeler said "It will be useful to students and research scholars. In those days I used to frequently visit Connemara Library to gather study material and to cull out points from the books that were out of reach. Now this new system has dispensed with such a physical travel, saving valuable time. Project MUSE: 300 "HTML5" Open Access Books Now Available on the Redesigned MUSE Platform

Project MUSE is the highly-acclaimed online collection of humanities and social science scholarship. Almost 300 open access (OA) books are now available from Project MUSE, on a newly designed platform that represents a major step forward in OA publishing in these fields. HTML5 will be used rather than static PDFs to deliver the books in a highly-discoverable and adaptable format. The books will include titles from Johns Hopkins University Press, Cornell University Press, Duke University Press, University of Hawai'i Press, University of Michigan Press, Syracuse University Press, The MIT Press, and Temple University Press.

A collection of almost 600 OA books in PDF format, that were already available on MUSE, have been greatly enhanced by the new "HTML5 OA" titles, bringing the total of OA books to over 800. MUSE plans to add more HTML5 OA books each year. A two-year grant of nearly \$1 million from the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, which concluded this summer, made this initiative possible. Project MUSE anticipates hosting hundreds more OA scholarly books, funded through initiatives including the NEH Humanities Open Book program, Knowledge Unlatched, TOME, Mellon grants, and other publisher- and institution-driven programs. Along with the more than 54,000 books and over 650 scholarly journal titles the open access content on MUSE is also fully integrated and supported on the platform. Inquiries from publishers and other content creators are welcome by MUSE with scholarship they wish to make freely available, with wide reach and rich options for discovery, linking, and transformative impact.

'Delhi State Booksellers & Publishes Association'(DSBPA) is the oldest Association of Book Trade in India, being established in 1942. It has about 500 National Level Publishers and Book sellers registered under it. The Association takes care of all Book trade related problems in India, like Allotment of ISBN numbers to the Books, Govt's Good Offices committee Rates, tender Issues, etc.

Speaking on the function as a chief guest, Prof. Shabahat Husain, President of Indian Library Association emphasized the urgent need of changing the strategies of the Book trade in view of home based internet access, free availability of digitized books and journals and emergence of online vendors like Amazon, Apple and Google. The President Shri Parmil Mittal, in addition to Vice President, Treasurer of DSPBA shared their views on the occasion. The Programme was conducted by the Secretary, DSPBA Mr. Kartik Raj Kushvah.



One day conference on "Library Services: Trends and Techniques in Traditional and Digital Era' organised

On the occasion of Dr. S.R. Ranganathan's death Anniversary on 27th September 2018, 'Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences, Indore organised a one day conference on "Library Services Trends and Techniques in Traditional and Digital Era'. Prof. Shabahat Husain, President of ILA, was invited as the Chief Guest and Keynote speaker at the Inaugural session. Dignitaries on the Dias included Dr. S. P Sood, Dr. P. R. Meena, and Dr. I. R. Kumar.

Prof. Husain in his address highlighted the remarkable contribution of Dr. Ranganathan which won him acclaim at National and International level. Ranganathan not only started Public Library movement in India but also established Library Science Departments of studies in BHU, DU and DRTC. He authored 65 books and about 1000 research articles to his credit. The Govt. of India honored him with Padamshree in 1957 and as National Research Professor in 1965 along with C.V. Raman and J. C. Bose. Prof. Husain also highlighted the need of such a conference dealing with the theme of 'Library Services Trends and Techniques in Traditional and Digital Era', as the Libraries in India are still in Traditional and Digital Forms. At the end of the conference, Best Paper presentation and Best Poster Presentation awards were announced. The Program was organised and conducted by Dr. Anil Kumar Patidar, Librarian of the Institute. Some of the papers were also presented through skype.




