NEW EDUCATION POLICY 2020

The Indian government Wednesday replaced a 34-year-old National Policy on Education, framed in 1986, with the New Education Policy of 2020. The NEP, approved by the union cabinet, makes sweeping reforms in school and higher education including teaching. Some of the biggest highlights of the NEP 2020 are, 1) a single regulator for higher education institutions, 2) multiple entry and exit options in degree courses, 3) discontinuation of MPhil programmes, 4) low stakes board exams, 5) common entrance exams for universities. The Policy recommends on increasing GER; Restructuring of Institutions; Multidisciplinary Education; Regulatory Structure; Improving Research; Foreign Universities and Vocational education on the part of Higher Education.

The policy recommends a number of important issues on digital education as Alternative modes of quality education should be developed when in-person education is not possible, as observed during the recent pandemic. Several interventions must be taken to ensure inclusive digital education such as: (i) developing two-way audio and video interfaces for holding online classes, (ii) creating a

digital repository of coursework, learning games and simulations through virtual reality, (iii) use of other channels such as television, radio, mass media in multiple languages to ensure reach of digital content where digital infrastructure is lacking, (iv) creating virtual labs on existing e-learning platforms to provide students with hands-on experiment-based learning, and (v) training teachers on how to become high-quality online content creators.

On the other side, the policy also recommends on technology in education. The National Education Technology Forum (NETF) will be setup to facilitate decision making on the induction, deployment and use of technology. This Forum will provide evidence-based advice to central and state-governments on technology-based interventions.

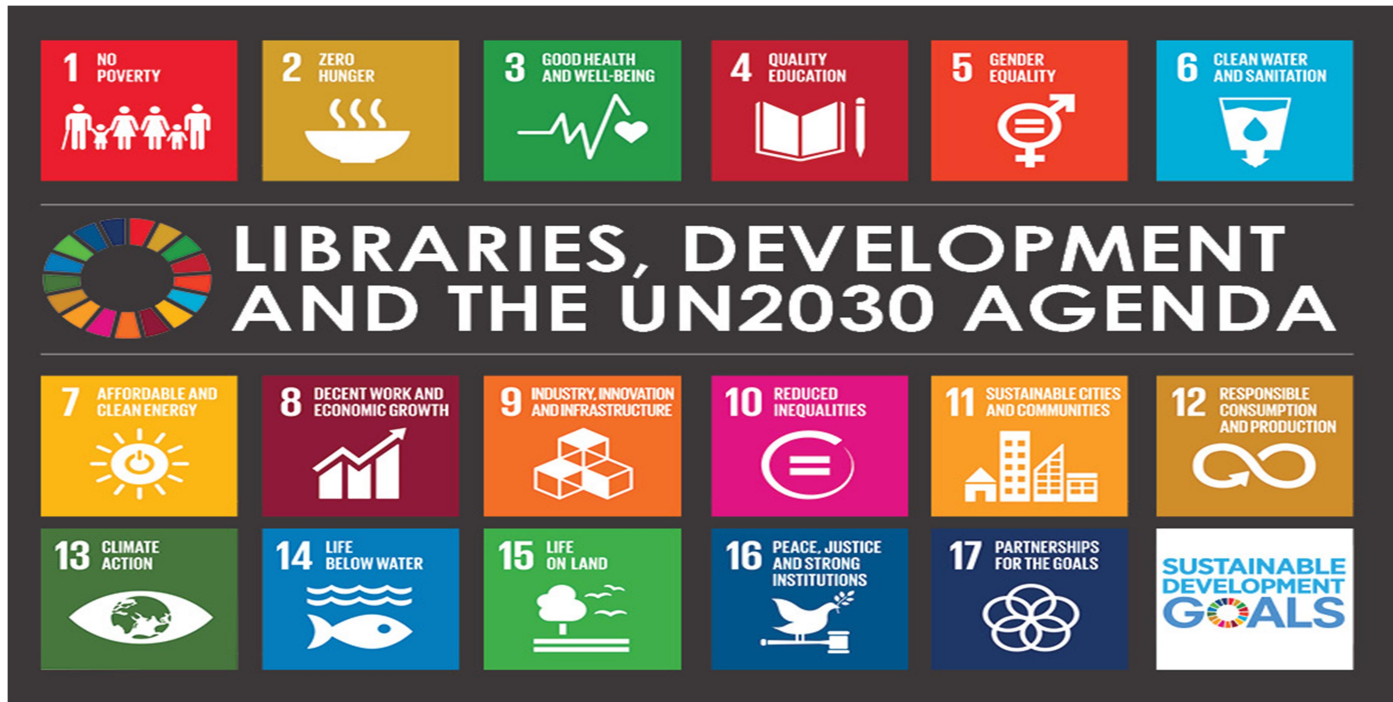

under SDG 16: Promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels:

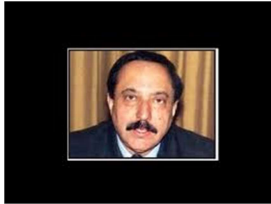

Condolence: Dr. H.K.Kaul



Dr. H.K.Kaul, former chief librarian of IIC, New Delhi, a poet, an author and cultural stalwart of the capital breathed his last at Primus hospital on July 01, 2020. He was 79. It creates a big loss to the library science fraternity. Dr. Kaul has been associated with IIC since its inception. Kaul was

known for forming DELNET, a network of over 1,500 libraries in South Asia, in 1988, and was the founder-member and president of the Poetry Society (India), which he set up in 1984, along with poets Keshav Malik, J P Das and Lakshmi Kannan. Dr. Kaul worked hard to take DELNET to its heights which was later established as a full-fledged library network. Besides his proclamation as librarian, he was also a poet and author. 'Travellers' India: An Anthology' is his among much acclaimed works.
