





- Papers should be in English with abstract and keywords with APA style citation. Paper(s) should be submitted latest by 25th May 2022 through e-mail to: libraryandinformationcentre@dmscollege.ac.in.
- Only participants presenting the paper in the Conference will get paper presentation certificate.

The details of the author i.e. name of the author, designation, title of the article, abstract, name of the affiliating institution, mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address should be enclosed along with the paper to be submitted.

It may be noted by the author(s) that the paper submitted on theme/sub-themes should not have already been published elsewhere.

International Conclave: 6th LTC organized by Somaiya Vidyavihar University and Informatics India Ltd.

Report on the 6th LTC2022: Research Data Management and Stewardship: Building Blocks of Open Science.

International event LTC 2022 organized by Informatics (India) Ltd Bengaluru, Somaiya Vidyavihar and Somaiya Vidyavihar University Mumbai from 28th to 30th April 2022. The Event was on hybrid mode. Total -129 participants attended this event online and physical. The LTC 2022 International event was having the Tutorials, Inaugural function, Sessions on six sub themes, Special Lecture of Informatics and Valedictory function. Some of the sessions were kept open for Librarians, research students and academicians, where more than 200 plus people attended the program.

The following Six Thematic Sessions were presented during the three-day Conclave:

- 1. Open Science, Frameworks Policies & Open Data by Prof. Gautam Menon
- 2. Infrastructure for RDM by Prof. Bjorn Brembs
- 3. Research Data Lifecycle, Data Management, and DMP by Dr. S. Venkataraman
- 4. Data Governance, Data Sharing, and Reuse by Prof. Kevin Crowston
- 5. Research Life Cycle, Data Management, and

Standards by Dr. A. J. Million 6. Research Data Services by Dr. Andrew Cox

In International Conclave there were two pre-conclave tutorials, arranged by well-known international experts as:

Tutorial 1: By Dr. Robin Rice, Data Librarian and Head of research data support, University of Edinburgh, Scotland, UK

Topic: Research Data Management: Basics Dr. Robin Rice presented her topic and explained on basics of Research Data Management. The interactive tutorial sessions were very useful to the participants and cleared all queries raised by the participants.

Tutorial 2: By Prof Kevin Crowston Associate Dean for Research, Distinguished Professor of Information Science, Syracuse University, USA.

Topic: Building Capability for Research Data Management.

Professor Kevin Crowston presented about Building capability of Research Data Management with some case studies he had undertaken for his research study. In this session many participants raised queries pertaining to the topic and the discussion was very fruitful.



The Inaugural function was opened after Institute Invocation and lamp lightening by dignitaries.

The Informatics 18th Annual lecture was organized and was open to all to attend. The lecture was delivered by the renowned speaker Prof. Ram Ramaswamy, Visiting professor IIT Delhi and the session was presided by Prof. Gautam Mandal, Chair, Department of Theoretical Physics, TIFR, Mumbai. The topic of the deliberation was Scholarship Unbound: Flattening the uneven access landscape which spoke about the very limited access that most scholars must published literature. There have been many efforts from many distinct sources on how this issue can be addressed both physically and digitally and these range from creation of JSTOR or the eJournals Delivery Service (eJDS). There was discussion and deliberation about the various initiatives and the impact that these services have had on the academic landscape.
